Wichita County Temporary Mobile COVID-19 Testing Site

Wichita Falls, Texas – A temporary mobile COVID-19 testing site will be open to the public this Friday, June 12 from 10:00am to 4:00pm in the parking lot at the Wichita Falls – Wichita County Public Health District. The testing site will be operated by the Texas Department of Health and Human Services, Texas Emergency Medical Task Force, Texas Division of Emergency Management and the Texas Military Department.

Testing is free and available for anyone who may be experiencing possible COVID-19 symptoms. Anyone requesting a test will be screened and must have one or more of the following symptoms: fever and/or chills, cough (dry or productive), fatigue, body aches/muscle or joint pain, shortness of breath, sore throat, headaches, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, nasal congestion and loss of taste and/or smell. Results are typically received in two to five days.

For those who are interested in testing, you can utilize the drive-thru testing option, or walk-up option. Appointments can be made in advance, but are not required for testing. To register for an appointment please visit www.txcovidtest.org or call 512-883-2400.

It is important to note; critical healthcare workers and first responders can be tested with or without symptoms.
