Gary P. Nunn to Headline Fourth in the Falls Freedom Fest Concert

Wichita Falls, Texas – Gary P. Nunn will be the headliner for this year's FREE concert at the Fourth in the Falls Freedom Fest event! Gary P. Nunn has been taking Texas to the country and Texas country to the world for some 40 years now, establishing himself as an icon of Lone Star music. A founding father of the progressive country movement out of Austin in the 1970's that changed the face of popular music, Nunn is also an independent music pioneer who continues to oversee his own record label and song publishing companies, manage his own career (with the help of his wife Ruth) and play most every weekend at top music venues throughout Texas and beyond.

Opening for Gary P. Nunn is Malford Milligan, a Texas-based soul, blues and gospel singer who has been compared to Otis Redding, Al Green and James Carr. Milligan is an eight-time award winner as "Best Vocalist" at the annual Austin Music Awards.

In addition to the two bands, the 80th Flying Training Wing from Sheppard Air Force Base will conduct a flyover during the National Anthem. Sheppard will also have a tent located in the center of the event with an EOD (Explosive Ordnance Disposal) demonstration, photo opportunities, kids' activities, as well as personnel from the local Recruiting Office standing by to answer any questions about joining the world's greatest Air Force.
