## CERTIFIED MAIL

Dear Neighbor:

This letter is to advise you that on multiple occasions your dog has been barking or howling for at least fifteen minutes in a manner that is disturbing to your neighbors.

Dogs may bark for a good reason. Sometimes they get a response and continue the behavior. However, dogs that bark frequently are a problem, and often owners do not realize that their dog may be causing a disturbance to their neighbors.

These incidents are being documented, and it is hoped that this will not continue as the City of Wichita Falls does consider frequent or long and continued barking to be a nuisance.
