City to Offer Disposal of Natural Christmas Trees After Christmas

Wichita Falls, Texas- The City of Wichita Falls Sanitation Department, in partnership with the Parks Department has designated four locations for residents to dispose of natural Christmas trees beginning December 26, 2024.

All tree stands, decorations and lights must be removed before drop off. No artificial trees will be accepted. The trees will be used as mulch throughout city parks. There is no charge for disposal at the Transfer Station or the landfill for residents who show proof of residency and a residential utility account with the City of Wichita Falls.

There will be no pickup of Christmas Trees left by the curb during regular trash pickup.

The following drop-off locations are open until Sunday, January 19, 2025:

Lucy Park on Sunset Lane off Seymour Highway. Drive to the south side of the park near the Duck Pond and follow the signs. The location is open 24 hours a day.

Kiwanis Park at 4400 Southwest Parkway. Drop-off is next to the Parks Maintenance Building at the park's entrance. This location is open 24 hours a day.

The Transfer Station is at 3200 Lawrence Road. It is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The City Landfill at 10984 Wiley Road. Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. Saturday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
