Rescue application and guidelines

- Rescue groups should assign a delegate to come to the shelter and physically evaluate animals they are tagging for their organization, this needs to be done prior to the release date of the animal. An ASC staff will bring the animal out for the evaluation. Only ASC staff are allowed entrance into authorized personnel areas.
- All animals should be tagged no later than 8am of their review date through email at wfasc@wichitafallstx.gov. or by calling (940) 761-8894 and leave a message with the name of your organization and the 8 digit animal ID number.
- Animals will be released to the rescue group who places the first tag on the animal. Other organizations can put a second tag in case the first one falls through.
- It is the responsibility of each group to evaluate the animals they are wanting to tag. Rescue groups must pick up animal no later than close of business the following day for the release date of animal.
