## 2020 Great Texas Warrant Roundup with New Amnesty Period Program

Wichita Falls, Texas—Once again it's time for Texas law enforcement to increase its efforts in serving outstanding arrest warrants. This year, Wichita Falls is offering an amnesty period from Monday, February 3rd through Friday, February 21st. To avoid arrest by the Marshal's office, individuals with outstanding city citations are encouraged to pay their warrants off early in person, by mail, or online at <https://tx-wichitafalls3.civicplus.com/441/Paying-Citations>.

The annual [2020 Texas Warrant Roundup](#) will begin Monday, February 24th and end Friday, March 6th. This will be the 13th year that Texas has done this. It is estimated that many local law enforcement agencies statewide participate in the roundup. Citizens who have outstanding warrants for anything from traffic violations, unpaid parking tickets to those with higher charges are invited to voluntarily comply with the local courts. The incentive to do so? Those who don't **may face being arrested at their job or at home in front of their family.**

In Wichita Falls, notices have already been mailed to individuals with active warrants. Listed below are instructions on how to clear a warrant.
