Portion of Greenbriar to be Closed for Sewer Repair

Wichita Falls, Texas- The City of Wichita Falls Public Works Department will perform a sewer line repair at the intersection of Greenbriar and Southwest Parkway.

During a recent repair of the City's Wastewater Collections System, a post-repair inspection of the pipeline detected another failure of the pipeline, downstream of the original repair. After a short period of planning and coordination, the wastewater repair crews are now prepared to make this scheduled repair.

Starting Monday, June 26th, at 10 pm, the Southwest Parkway eastbound right turn lane and westbound left turn lane southbound onto Greenbriar will be closed. There will be no through traffic allowed southbound onto Greenbriar.

The main lanes of Southwest Parkway will remain open. Driveways to nearby businesses will remain open but may have to be accessed from the south end of Greenbriar.

During this time citizens will need to exercise caution in traveling this area in an effort to protect themselves and the City workers that will be in the street repairing the infrastructure.

We appreciate your continued understanding and patience as we continue to maintain the wastewater collections system for the community.
